The beautiful Šilheřovice Golf Resort is located in the castle park with centuries-old trees, dominated by the Rothschild Castle, Neptune's Fountain and other cultural monuments. It is the only full eighteenhole parkland course in Central Europe, and is only 15 minutes from the centre of Ostrava. The aently undulating terrain, the pleasant shade of the trees, the symbiosis of nature, fairways and greens, allow you to enjoy golf with all your senses. The course requires a well-thought-out strategy and precise play, where accuracy and a feel for the game are more important than the length of the shots. This is one of the reasons why the course regularly hosts top competitions. The newly-renovated historic Palmenhaus Clubhouse illustrates the uniqueness of the resort. The golf club is the third oldest in the Czech Republic and the oldest in Moravia, where it has been operating since 1968.

Prosper Golf Resort Čeladna, located close to the picturesque village of Čeladna in the north-east of the Czech Republic, in the heart of the tallest peaks of Beskydy mountains, offers top class sport and leisure activities, and much more. Both eighteenhole golf courses are ideally situated in the local landscape. The courses offer many water hazards, sand traps, Scottish bunkers and spacious, beautifully shaped greens. Miguel Ángel Jiménez is the designer of the golf courses. In 2009, 2010 and 2011, the resort hosted PGA European Tour events, namely the 2009 Moravia Silesia Open and 2010 and 2011 Czech Open. The resort offers a wide range of services, including an indoor hall with two full swing simulators, both side driving range, spacious putting green, and short game area including chipping green with both sand and grass practice bunkers. You can also visit our stylish Golf Restaurant with a water view terrace from where you can see both of the 18th greens, the Old Course and the New Course. There is also a well stocked Pro Shop, modern Prosper Horse Ranch and CCTV monitored parking. In late autumn, with the first snow, the resort becomes a top quality cross-country skiina venue. The skiers can choose from three different circuits with stunning views of the surrounding countryside.

The golf resort in Kravaře in the Opava Region is the perfect place for sports and relaxation. The ideal setting for the best golfing experience is the eighteenhole course among strems and centuries-old trees, overlooking a magnificent Baroque castle. Some of the courses are actually among the oldest in the country. In the Moravian-Silesian Region, you can find a golf course with a mining tower converted into a lookout point and a course at the foot of mountains surrounded by beautiful views. Six championship courses await you in this fantastic region, all within 40 kilometres of each other. You can enjoy the game on high-quality courses with views of mountains, parks and industrial heritage. Few regions in the Czech Republic can boast such a rich golf infrastructure.

Northern Moravia is also one of the greenest parts of the country, vet features good transport accessibility by car, train and plane. In addition to quality golf experiences, there are many tourist attractions waiting for you. The Beskydy and Jeseníky Mountains offer trails for hiking, cycling and downhill, as well as cross-country skiing. The region has a rich cultural and industrial heritage. In Ostrava, you can visit the internationally unique Dolní Vítkovice complex, where coal was mined and pig iron produced between 1828 and 1998. Now this industrial complex has been transformed into a unique educational, cultural and social centre with the unique Bolt Tower offering fantastic views from the top of a blast furnace. You can also visit historical gems such as the Hradec nad Moravicí, Bruntál, Hukvaldy and Sovinec castles and châteaux. The region hosts many important museums and galleries, and the Plato gallery of contemporary art also opened in 2022. The entire region is easily accessible from the nearby airports in Vienna, Brno, Ostrava, Krakow and Katowice.

The Golf Club Ostravice course was designed by Chris Johnson. It is a championship 18-hole par 72 parkland golf course. The first five holes are very open and three of them are played around water, which will also test the mental qualities of the golfers. The complex also includes the beautiful Green Inn hotel, with its restaurant with a terrace, a separate lounge and great food. The hotel offers convention facilities and a wellness center. In the summer, you can rent an electric bike at the resort, and in the winter, you can rent cross country skiing gear as the course is transformed into a quality cross-country skiing track in the winter.



Ropice Golf Resort deservedly belongs among the top 10 Czech golf courses and is a popular course for both professionals and players of all levels of experience. ČGF tournaments are held here each year. The location of the eighteen-hole course offers stunning panoramic views of the massif of the Slezské Beskydy Mountains. dominated by Javorový vrch. Ropice Golf Resort offers players a great gaming experience on championship links. Its colourfulness lies in the numerous bunkers, undulating nature of the fairways and interestingly shaped greens and water hazards. Ropice Golf Resort was designed and modeled by the leading Austrian architect Hans Georg Erhardt. In 2023 will be completed the construction of the next nine holes. The resort will thus expand to a 27 hole championship course.

The Lipiny Golf Resort (Karviná-Lipiny) is an eighteenhole golf course that will satisfy professional players and beginners alike. This superbly appointed golf resort features the nine-hole Master Course, the nine-hole Public Course, illuminated practice areas to improve your game and a restaurant boasting an interesting architectural design. A replica of a mining tower is a landmark of the entire area and offers a stunning view of the golf course. The Lipiny Golf Resort offers a unique opportunity to all those who want to enter the beautiful world of golf. Prices are set to make the sport truly accessible to the general public in Karviná and its surroundings. No certificate (former green card) is required to access the Master and Public courses.
