

CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING IN THE BESKYDY MOUNTAINS

Imagine a unique network of groomed cross-country ski trails in the easternmost mountain range of the Czech Republic the Beskydy Mountains. Connected here are groomed trails with a length of about 300 km throughout the Beskydy Mountains.

PUSTEVNY
